



# 2024 CFBA Building Awards & Members Choice Competition

## Information & Entry Form

### CFBA Building Awards

All entries will be evaluated by a panel of judges (minimum of 3 judges) in 10 categories using the attached scoring criteria. Successful entries that achieve the Gold, Silver or Bronze scoring threshold will receive their respective Award, which will be presented at the annual conference.

All Gold, Silver and Bronze Awards will be announced at the CFBA's Annual Conference on April 23th, 2024 with the corresponding plaques being presented to the builders.

### Members Choice Competition

The *Members Choice Competition* will take place at the Annual Conference and will be determine the 3 top projects across all categories. This voting will be via ranked ballot.

[i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> choice = 5 pts; 2<sup>nd</sup> choice = 4 pts; 3<sup>rd</sup> choice = 3 pts; 4<sup>th</sup> choice = 2 pts; 5<sup>th</sup> choice = 1 pt.]

Each individual member or member organization will receive one ranking ballot and only allowed a single vote by one voting delegate per member in attendance. The top 3 projects ranked (by vote count) will each receive a Members Choice Award. The top-ranking Members Choice project will receive the **Glen White Project of the Year Award**. In addition, both the winning Builder and Project Owner will receive a plaque in recognition of the Project of the Year win.

### Details

The entry must be submitted by a CFBA Builder member and the project completed after October 2021 and not previously submitted.

**All Entries must be received by Friday, March 8, 2024. First entry is free.** All additional entries require an entry fee of \$50 per entry which will be invoiced to the applicant upon receipt of multiple entries. **We are unable to accept late entries.**

The project information received for each qualifying entry will be exhibited via a display board or poster at the CFBA's Annual Conference on Tuesday, April 23rd, 2024. Display boards will be assembled by the CFBA and may be collected by the applicants directly following the event.

All of the winning entries will receive recognition and media exposure, potentially with Business, Agricultural, and Construction publications, via the CFBA website, and others. ALL qualifying entries will be displayed on the CFBA website (post-event).

# Scoring Criteria for 2024 CFBA Building Awards

Criteria	Max Points
1. Building Design c/w engineered drawings <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Completeness of plans, easy to follow,</li> <li>- Specific details shown clearly</li> </ul>	15 points
2. Resource Efficiency (Materials, Energy, Water) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Building design and construction characteristics that cost-effectively conserve resources. (i.e., high efficiency lighting/ motors/fans, heat pumps, heat recovery units, water recycling, including grey water collection &amp; re-use, natural ventilation, etc.)</li> <li>- Incorporation of practical resource generating measures and technologies into the building. (i.e., solar/wind power/hydro power, etc.)</li> </ul>	15 points
3. Building Interior <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Fit and finish, colour choices,</li> <li>- Any specialized finishes,</li> <li>- Over-all appearance</li> </ul>	15 points
4. Building Exterior <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Fit and finish, colour choices,</li> <li>- Any specialized finishes</li> <li>- Over-all appearance</li> </ul>	10 points
5. Building Unique Features <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Any features that normally would not be present but added to enhance suitability or efficiency</li> </ul>	10 points
6. Creative Use of Materials <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Use of materials or installation of materials that show some design creativity</li> </ul>	10 points
7. Design and Construction Economy <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Approximate finished cost per sq. ft. of effectively usable space for production, storage, work.</li> <li>- Excludes interior non-fixed, furniture &amp; furnishings</li> <li>- Excludes exterior landscaping</li> </ul>	10 points
8. Innovations <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Incorporation of a new idea or concept that has not been seen in this type of structure</li> </ul>	10 points
9. Curbside Appeal/Aesthetics <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Appropriate site clean-up, perimeter drainage in place, driveway and/or pathways suitable for good access, lighting located at entryways, no obvious safety hazards</li> </ul>	5 points

## 2024 CFBA Awards – Entry Categories

1. **Dairy** (an on-farm facility for the housing of dairy cows or their offspring, milk parlors or milk houses)
2. **Swine** (an on-farm facility for the housing of boars, dry sows, gilts, farrowing sows, nursing piglets, weanling piglets, growers or feeder pigs)
3. **Poultry** (an on-farm facility for the growing or raising of broilers, breeders or layers; chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese or other fowl, including on-farm hatchery facilities)
4. **Other Livestock** (any other on-farm facility for the accommodation of livestock not included in the other categories, e.g. beef or sheep, etc.)
5. **Farm Storage** (an on-farm facility for storing, servicing or repairing farm machinery. Combination machinery/bulk storage. Storage, drying, preserving or processing of forages, grains, fresh fruit or vegetables. Storage or mixing of hazardous agricultural chemicals)
6. **Horse I** – completed project value up to \$750,000 (an on-farm facility for the accommodation of horses including stables, training arenas, and tack rooms, etc.). Completed project value includes supply, install and other related to: Building foundation, floors, wall assemblies with cladding, roof structure with cladding, insulation, all stalls incl. hardware, windows, doors, and cabinetry. Does not include major sub trade costs for excavation, electrical, mechanical and landscaping. Does not include preconstruction costs such as: design, architectural, engineering, development charges or permits.)
7. **Horse II** – completed project value over \$750,000 (same explanation as #6)
8. **Hobby and Recreational I** – completed project value up to \$250,000 (a building for hobbies, crafts, recreation, workshops, studios, boat house, picnic shelter, farm office, garages or backyard storage). Completed project value includes supply, install, and other costs related to: building foundation, floors, wall assemblies with cladding, roof structure with cladding, insulation, windows, doors, and cabinetry. Does not include major sub trade costs for excavation, electrical, mechanical and landscaping. Does not include pre-construction costs such as: design, architectural, engineering, development charges or permits.)
9. **Hobby and Recreational II** – completed project value over \$250,000 (same explanation as #8)
10. **Commercial and Institutional** (a facility for the sale of goods or services to either wholesale or retail market, for the assembly or storage of any piece of equipment or goods destined for the marketplace or a facility providing service to the community, public buildings such as, but not limited to, community centers, recreation facilities, fire halls, town/township halls)
